

## Placemarks Clustering

**Placemarks clustering allow** you display points representing clusters of features within some pixel distance. Instead of displaying the placemarks from within a search radius, a single icon (marker) will be shown, together with the number of placemarks found there. Zooming the map in/out will re-compute the clusters accordingly.

You can control the behavior of the cluster strategy by setting its distance and threshold properties. The **distance** determines the search radius (in pixels) for features to cluster. The **threshold** determines the minimum number of features to be considered a cluster.
